
Mountain Clove Run



DIRECTIONS

- Start at the Greene County Visitor Center on Route 23B in Leeds. Follow County Route 23B East to Main Street to the Village
- At traffic light, take a right onto West Bridge Street to 9W South. Follow for a half mile and continue straight on 23A West through Palenville, Haines Falls, Tannersville and Hunter.
- For riders who want a thrilling experience, travel along Platte Clove Road, the steepest road in the Catskills. In Tannersville at the traffic light, make a left onto Railroad Avenue and follow to County Route 16/Platte Clove Road. Enjoy your ride and be sure to return to 23A East to finish the Mountain Clove Run.
- · Continue to follow 23A West through Jewett and Lexington until you get to Route 23. Follow signs to Prattsville for a short distance and return to Route 23A and Route 23 connection.
- Take Route 23 East to Windham. Stav on Route 23 for another 15 miles, and then make a left at traffic light onto Cauterskill Road in Leeds (Barnwood Restaurant is on the right).
- At the end of the road make a right onto Route 23B, which brings you back to the Greene County Visitor Center in Leeds.

The Mountain Clove Run offers one of the most

breathtaking rides through the Catskills. As you drive into the mountains, some of the highest peaks in Greene County rise above you, providing incredible views of the region's landscape, and access to scenic vistas such as the Kaaterskill Clove.

This route passes through quaint towns with great places to stop for a meal and shopping at unique stores and boutiques. Navigate the natural twists and turns that will test drive your skills on the rail, and enjoy the ride.



The **Emerald Isle Tour** travels through Greene County's Irish-settled countryside, offering breathtaking scenery and expansive views. Follow the shamrocks on Route 145 to the Irish land of East Durham, home of the Annual Irish Festival, Irish Arts Week, and Catskill Mountain Thunder. This route gives riders the chance to experience Cunningham Road, one of the most scenic roads in Greene County.



Catskill Tannersville Tannersville Palenville **DIRECTIONS** • Start at the Greene County Visitor Center on Route 23B in Leeds. Follow County Route 23B East to 9W South for about 1 mile and continue straight on 23A East through Palenville, Haines Falls, Tannersville and Hunter, Mountain Clove Scenic Byway. · For riders who want a thrilling experience, travel along Platte Clove Road, the steepest road in the Catskills. In Tannersville, at the traffic light, make a left onto Railroad Avenue and follow to County Route 16/Platte Clove Road. Continue onto West Saugerties Road to end and make a left onto Blue Mountain Road/ Route 35. Follow Route 212 and make a right onto 28 West to continue the Tour. · Continue to follow 23A West, make a left onto County Route 42, in

For a more adventurous ride, experience the Grand Tour of the Catskills as you wind through backcountry mountains and wide-open sweeping valleys in the heart of the Catskill Park. Ride the twisties at elevations around 3,500 feet as you drive alongside scenic streams and brooks. This route will make you feel as if you are carving through the mountains. Along the route you can expect to see high peaks, rolling farmlands, and quaint communities.
