

## 2025 Greene County List of Towns and Villages Parades Celebrating Memorial Day Events

On Thursday May 22nd at 9:00 a.m. Windham-Ashland-Jewett Central School will hold a Memorial Day service on the front lawn, Main Street in Windham, at 9:00 a.m. The community is invited to attend.

On Sunday May 25<sup>th</sup> at 1 p.m. American Legion Bunt Brewer Post 165 – 1 p.m. Lineup is at 12:30 p.m. at Bottini Fuel, 6158 Route 23A in Tannersville. The parade steps off at 1 PM and stops at the memorial monument on Main Street before ending at the Tannersville Village Hall where refreshments will be served.

<u>Town of Athens – Monday, May 26<sup>th</sup> at 9 a.m.</u> Lineup is at 8:30 a.m. at the Athens Ball field. Parade will go south on Route 385 to the Memorial Triangle, then up Second St and end at the Athens American Legion Post 187.

<u>Town of Cairo-Monday, May 26th at 11 a.m.</u> Lineup is at 10 a.m., Main St -Start point is across from Acra Building Supply, northwest up Main St to Angelo Canna Park. A wreath laying ceremony at the war memorial in the park immediately following the parade.

Catskill Monday, May 26th 11:00 a.m. VFW POST 770- Main St. - Memorial Service

<u>Town of Catskill- Monday, May 26<sup>th</sup> 2 p.m.</u> Lineup is at 1p.m. on Water St., the Parade will go down Main St, ending with a ceremony at the Dutchman's Landing Gazebo (weather dependent at The Historic Catskill Point Warehouse).

<u>Village of Coxsackie</u> – <u>Monday, May 26<sup>th</sup> 1:00 p.m.</u> Lineup is at 12:30 p.m. on Apple Blossom Lane and kicks off at 1 p.m. It will travel east on Mansion St (SR 385) to WW2 Monument and the Mansion St. Cemetery where a prayer will be offered, and Taps played. The parade will continue down to the Church Corners, then a stop at the WWI Monument. All are invited to the Village Hall.

<u>Town of Greenville & The Greenville American Legions' Memorial Day Parade- Monday, May 26<sup>th</sup> 10:15 a.m.</u> Lineup is at 9:30 a.m. at St. John the Baptist Church, Parade ending at the Gazebo in Greenville followed by a Memorial Day Service.

**Town of Lexington, May 26th 9a.m.** Lineup is at 8:30a.m. at the West Kill-Lexington Community Association, on Spruceton Road, West Kill. There will be a short service. The parade will stop at a nearby cemetery and then continue towards State Route 42 to the West Kill Community Cemetery, ending at the American flagpole located at the intersection of State Route 42. All are welcome to the West Kill Fire Station for ice cream.
